so when you can without  
cramping you or the business  
I would like to have you send  
me some if only a little at  
a time and I will put it on  
on the interest or on Papas acct -  
just whichever you would rather  
and if you want to you can  
send me a little any time  
for interest and that will be  
a help out. but every thing here  
is very high and likely higher  
there so maybe you wont be  
able to meet all the expenses  
and help us out too -

Papa left J.C. <sup>in</sup> the morning and

your letter (8) came in the  
P.M. and Geo. didnt leave I  
till in the night after Papa  
left in the morning so I  
sent it to him by George.

I am sending in this the only  
letter I have had from him since

he left - had some cards but no  
letters till this one. I do so

hope things will get straightened  
out down there right away  
and you wont have any  
more trouble. for I feel uneasy  
about you boys and things  
there. and hope you have all  
got through the worst now.

and will come out all right.

I would like ever so much  
to see you all for I get awful  
lonesome for my boys and

girls when I am away from  
you all - and Papa so far away  
too - but guess it will all come  
out right some way, some  
how, or some how else. dont  
you? How dare Lula stand the  
strain I imagine it is pretty  
hard for her too - I suppose you  
know Geo has gone to be a farmer  
in Montana they will use no  
horses - all machines work a  
cow or two some chickens and  
an auto. Well guess you will  
get all the news in Howard's  
letters - you and our wishes  
to you and Lula and also  
Frankie - Write to me whenever
